Aster laevis

Smooth Aster

- Give blue-violet “daisies” a starring role in meadows and sunny borders in the summer and into fall.
- Lovely blue green leaves clasp the upright stems, which rarely if ever require staking.



Growing Requirements & Size:

Average soil, sun-light shade, 1-3' tall.



Boltonia asteroides

'Pink Beauty'

Pink Boltonia

- Hundreds of small pink daisy-like flowers from September on.
- The leaves are bluish green and the stiff stems mean little or no staking.
- Great with Ironweed or Joe Pye Weed.



Growing Requirements & Size:

Average to dry soil, full sun, 4' tall.



Eupatorium rugosum

‘Chocolate’

White Snakeroot

- This is as close as it gets to a deer-proof plant.
- Bright white flowers really stand out against the chocolate leaves and shiny purple stems.
- Great with asters and a fine cut flower.
- Self sows.



Growing Requirements & Size:

Moist to average soils, full sun- light shade,
24-36" tall.

Gentiana andrewsii

Bottle Gentian



Growing Requirements & Size:

Average to moist soil, sun to light shade, 8" tall.

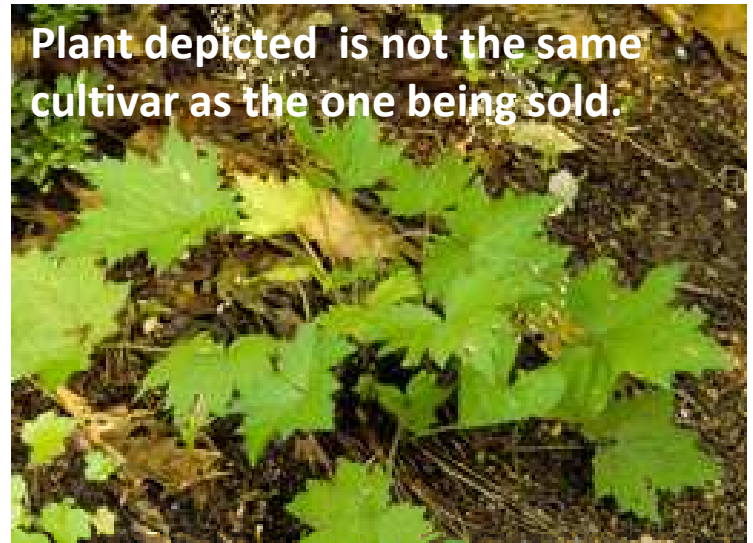
- The brilliant blue of these odd shaped flowers brightens up the late summer woodland or water's edge.
- The petals don't actually open, remaining closed like little bottles, hence its common name.

Heuchera villosa

'Autumn Bride'

Alumroot

- Bright, light green leaves, which are semi-evergreen.
- Smallish clouds of larger white flowers on 2 foot stalks in late summer/early fall.
- When planted in masses, it makes a nice show in early fall.



Growing Requirements & Size:

Rich, loamy, moist well-drained soil, part to full shade, 12 - 24" tall.



Liatris spicata

'Kobold'

Dense Blazing Star

- Purple, tufted flower heads are arranged in a long, dense spike blooming from top down.
- Protruding styles give the flower an overall feathery appearance.
- A Monarch magnet.
- The linear, grass-like leaves form attractive basal clumps and extend up flower stalk.



Growing Requirements & Size:

Moist to average soil, sun, 3-4' tall.

Solidago caesia

Wreath Goldenrod



Growing Requirements & Size:

Average to dry soil, shade to part sun, 6-12" tall.

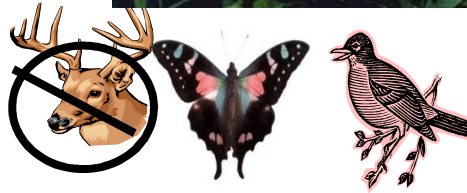


- A goldenrod for the shade garden!
- Arching wands of gold light up the woods.
- Does not spread by runners, but will self-sow and spread gradually.
- Attracts bees and butterflies but not deer.

Verbena hastata

Blue Vervain

- Deep purple spires on tall straight stems.
- Bloom at the same time as invasive purple loosestrife and rival it for showy beauty.
- A true biennial, it self-sows lavishly when happy.



Growing Requirements & Size:
Moist to average soil, sun-part shade, 2 - 4' tall.
